The photo exhibition 'Fulbright: Pushing Thresholds, Removing Borders' is the first and unique project in Chelyabinsk, organized by the

It aims at informing students, professors, scholars, and art professionals about the benefits of the participation in the Fulbright programs, as well as motivating potential Fulbright participants to have an international exchange experience.

The exhibition will launch in the Chelyabinsk State Museum of Fine Arts and will be open to the public from October 13th to 22nd, from 12:00 AM to 7:00 PM. Later, the exhibition will move around three university locations: Chelyabinsk State University, South Ural State University, and South Ural State Humanitarian Pedagogical University. The photo exhibition is expected to gather at least 1000 visitors.
